Marsh, an Indianapolis-based supermarket corporation used Electrical Equipment Company to provide two presentation and sound systems in their corporate headquarters. Two rooms in this facility include comprehensive systems that help the company achieve their goals in delivering dynamic presentations to their employees and guests.

The Marsh Auditorium features a large projection screen with both rear-projection and front-projection capabilities. The heart of the system in this room is a Peavy MediaMatrix computer-controlled digital signal processor that manages the system from the convenience of a custom software interface designed by Electrical Equipment Company.

The Boardroom contains a 42" flat-panel plasma monitor, video conferencing equipment, and a large conference table with microphones and speakers positioned at each chair. This *mix-minus* system constantly monitors each microphone, and adjusts speaker output levels according to the position of the active microphone so that feedback can be eliminated. Electrical Equipment Company also provided carpentry work to create and modify custom cabinetry within the room.

Each room is automated by a Crestron Control system, which provides automatic selection of audio and video sources, lighting controls, and in the boardroom, can close the window blinds at the push of a button.

This large Indianapolis-based life insurance company recently chose Electrical Equipment Company to install an audio and video presentation and control system in its large group conference room. This room features a Sanyo rear-screen projector, two RCA 36-inch and one 27-inch television monitors, and playback equipment, all controllable from the presenter's podium.

Installed in a podium is a touch screen monitor, linked with a Crestron control system in the room's equipment cabinet. While standing at the podium, a presenter can select appropriate lighting levels, turn on the necessary equipment and monitors, and control volume levels and source selection. In addition to displaying programming on the monitors throughout the room, the selected source is also displayed on a screen within the touch panel for the convenience of the presenter.

The main equipment rack consists of the Crestron control system, a VCR, DVD Player, and combination CD and cassette player. With the addition of inputs for a laptop computer and document presentation equipment, the system is capable of displaying nearly any media available and commonly in use today.
